Applications are due no later than April 25th. Scholarship recipients will be announced during the DSHS Scholarships Awards night. Arrangements will be made with students who attend other high schools or who are currently attending college.

Eligibility Criteria for Graduating High School Seniors:

- Planning to attend a technical school, college/university, or some other higher education program for the upcoming academic year.
- Involvement in the life of the church and/or youth ministry at DSUMC
- Christian leadership skills

Eligibility Criteria for Current College Students:

- Planning to continue further education
- Involvement in Christian Ministry/Service at DSUMC or another Christian organization
- Christian leadership skills

Required Forms:

- DSUMC Scholarship Application Form
- Copy of Transcript (unofficial is acceptable)
- OPTIONAL: Resume, reference letter, other supporting information

Submit completed application and required documents to the Dripping Springs United Methodist Church office, or email to Katrina Sherman at ksherman@dsumc.org no later than April 25th. Late applications will not be accepted.
